1. On Saturday, **February 14, 2015** you will report to the **Volunteer Command Center** at Castaic Lake Recreation Area.
 - a. A map with the address and directions to Castaic Lake is attached, below.
 - b. A map of the recreation area is also attached, below.
2. Volunteer **Parking is FREE.**
 - a. Mention the keyword **"CHAMBER ROCKS"** at the gate for FREE parking.
 - b. Park in **LOT #11**
3. There will be plenty of signage to help you locate the "Volunteer Command Center" where you will check-in and get instructions and assignments.
4. **WHAT TO WEAR:**
 - a. Wear comfortable clothing as well as a sweater; it may be a little chilly, especially in the morning.
 - b. A limited number of T-shirts will be provided for volunteers in various sizes on a first-come-first-serve basis.
 - c. Wear closed toe, comfortable shoes, you will be standing and moving around, a good pair of sneakers is a must.
 - d. You may also want to bring along a hat.
 - e. Wear sunscreen.
5. **FOOD:**
 - a. Breakfast: Make sure to eat a hearty breakfast on the day of. You will need your energy.
 - b. Lunch: A limited number of boxed lunches will be provided on a first come first serve basis for volunteers who are still working at noon.
 - c. Bring a reliable bottle of water.
 - d. Food vendors will also be available on site, you can chose to purchase lunch if you have food allergies, or prefer something other than what is provided.

- b. **SKIP FOR JACK VOLUNTEERS:** Meet at the Volunteer Command Center at 6:00a.m. You will be directed to the Skip for Jack area for further instruction once you have checked in at the Volunteer Command Center.
- c. **CANYON HS CHEER:** Report to the Volunteer Command Center at 7a.m. The Volunteer Coordinators will direct you to your stations. Please help us keep the park clean by picking up all color bags and cups from your area at the end of your shift. (Hours: 7a.m. to 10a.m.)
- d. **BOWMAN HS:** Report to the Volunteer Command Center at 7a.m. for further instruction. The Volunteer Coordinators will direct you to your stations. Please help us keep the park clean by picking up all water bottles and cups from your area at the end of your shift. (Hours: 7a.m. to 10a.m.)
- e. **GOLDEN VALLEY ROTC:** Report to the Volunteer Command Center at 7a.m. for further instruction.
- f. **ALL OTHER VOLUNTEERS:** Report to the Volunteer Command Center at your agreed upon time for further instruction and assignments.

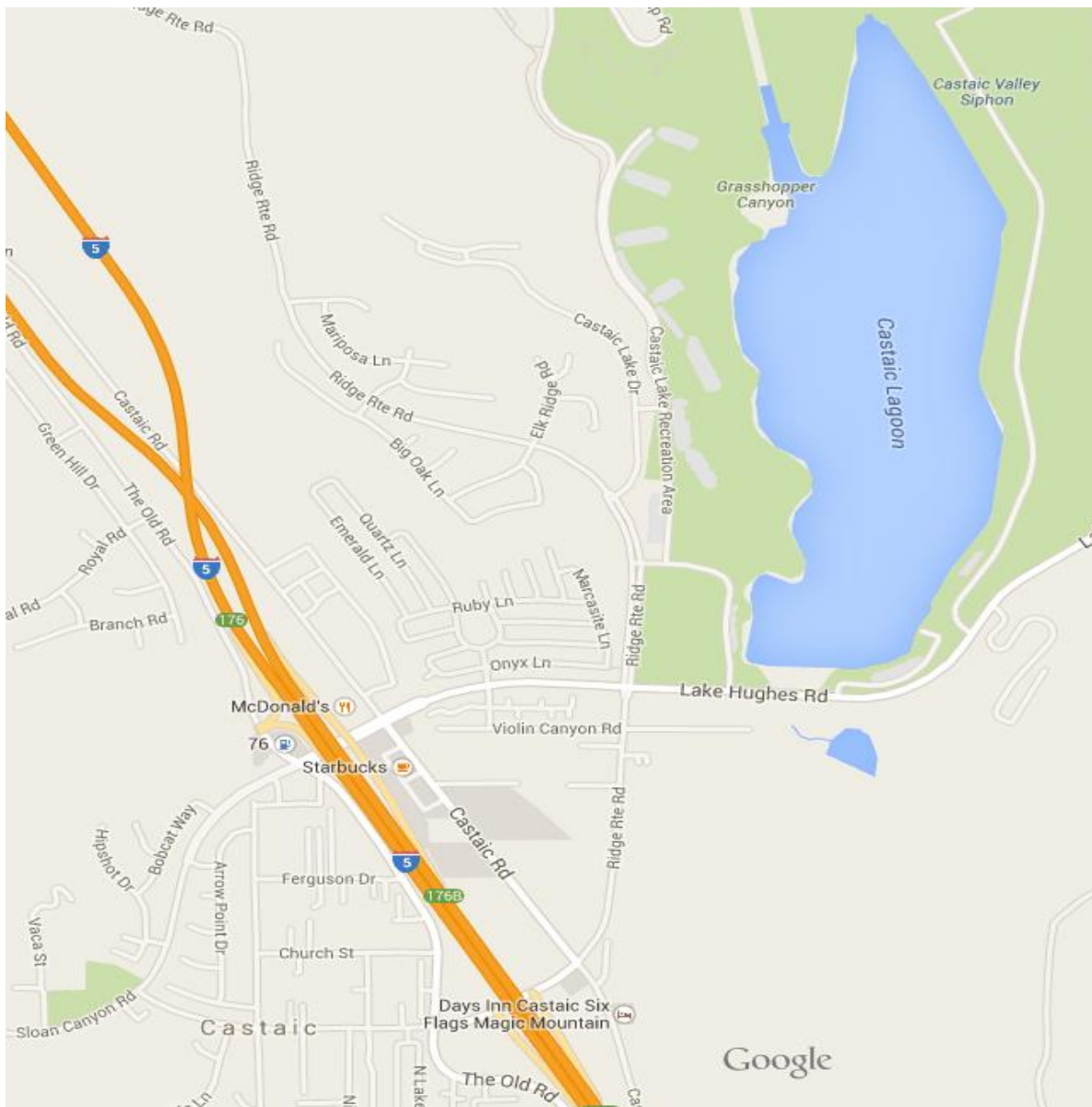
