In effect we are inviting the whole community to come and join us in displaying their artistry in exhibits or performing in our concert. The event will be packed with family fun and entertainment! Jack's Angels Foundation was inspired by the generosity and caring of this community for little "Jack-Jack" Demeter, age 3, who succumbed to DIPG—responsible for 80% pediatric brain tumor deaths annually. We would be honored to have our talented local youth come to celebrate and play with us, and our community groups and businesses join us in raising awareness for these heroic young people who lose their lives every year to DIPG and other childhood cancers.
