THE IMPORTANCE OF ADVOCACY

Brain tumors are the leading cause of death in children diagnosed with cancer, yet remains one of the least-funded areas of cancer research. Only 4% of the National Cancer Institute budget for research benefits pediatric cancer as a whole.

Briefly, all the childhood cancer awareness bills in Congress for the last 10 years containing provisions for the analysis of money-flow at NCI* have disappeared. What has been pieced-together from the wreckage is a comprehensive bill called the STAR Act with provisions for Survivorship, Treatment, Access, and Research for childhood cancer, minus the accountability factor. The DIPG Awareness Resolution HRes586, thanks to our Congressman Steve Knight, does what all the other "hard-law" bills do not: it asks for greater consideration for low-survival rate cancers (urgency) and years of life lost (children) with the NCI research grant process..
